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Requirements for Notarial of Affidavit of Legitimation by Subsequent Marriage:

Personal appearance of the signatories at the Consular Section of the Philippine Embassy.

If **personal appearance** at the Philippine Embassy is not possible, the applicants should personally appear at the nearest Philippine Consulate.

Requirements:

- Original document to be notarized and one photocopy;
- Two (2) copies of the data pages with signature page of the valid passports of the applicants
- Original Marriage Contract from the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) duly authenticated by the Department of Foreign Affairs (DFA) OR if married in France/Monaco, original copy of the Report of Marriage, and one photocopy
- Signature of two (2) disinterested witnesses of legal age
- Payment of 22.50 Euros per document in cash or La Poste mandat cash payable to the order of "Ambassade des Philippines"
